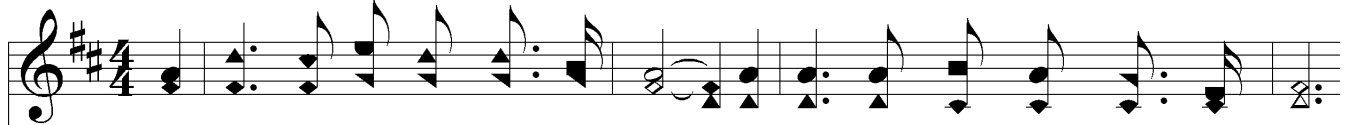
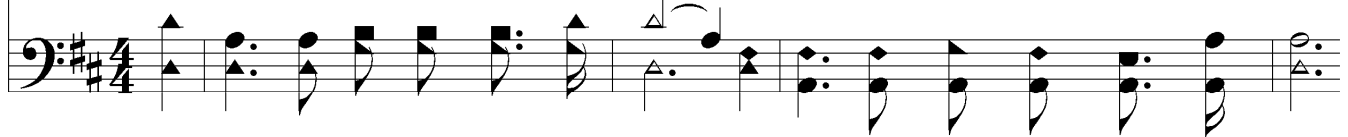


# I Know That My Redeemer Lives

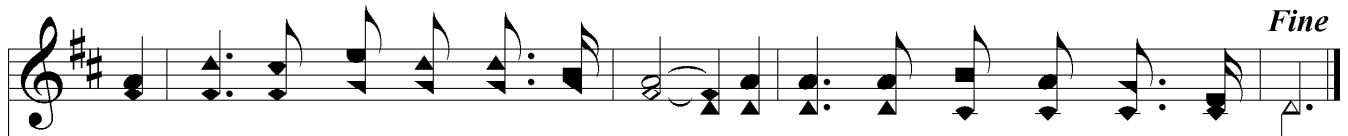
"For I know that my Redeemer liveth." – Job 19:25

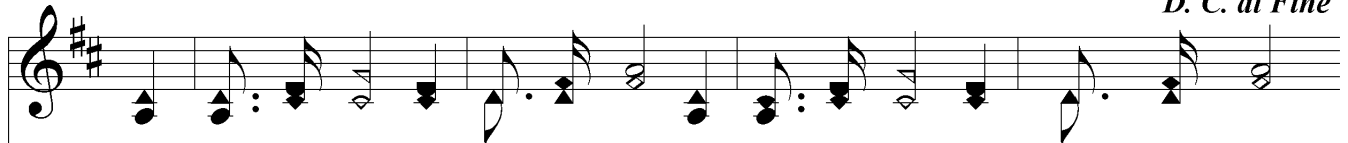
And crowns of vic - to - ry He gives To those who would His chil - dren be.
