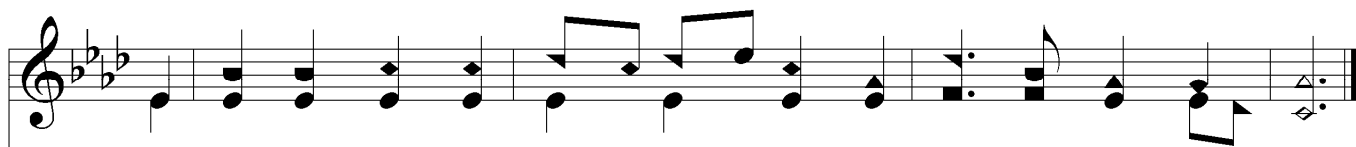


# I Say To All Men Far And Near
