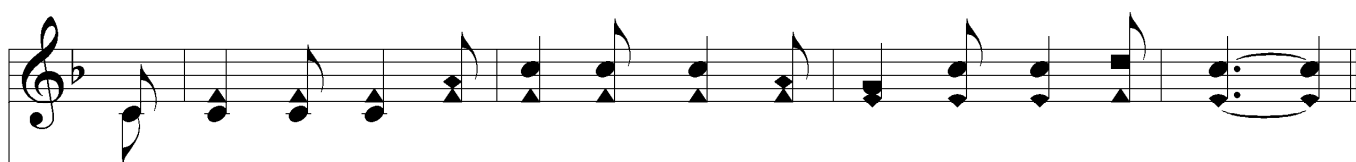


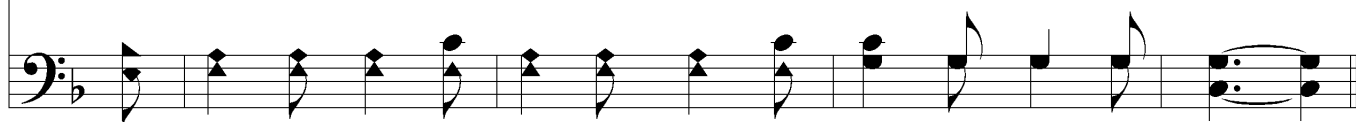
King Of Kings And Lord Of Lords

5. They suf - fer with their Lord be - low, They reign with Him a - bove;



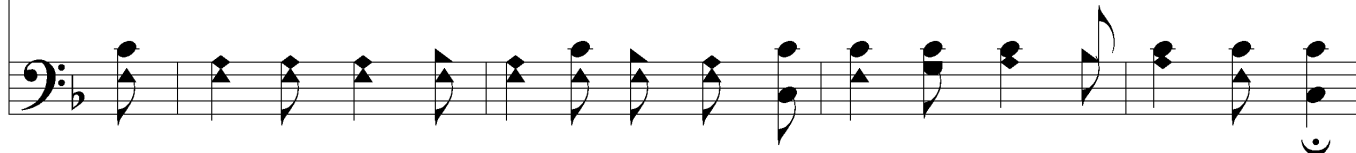
