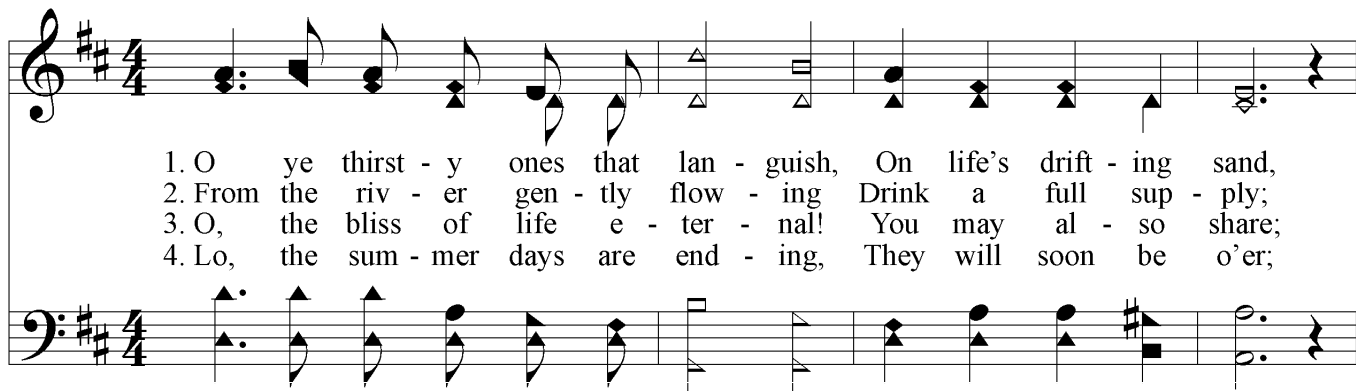


Whosoever Will May Come
