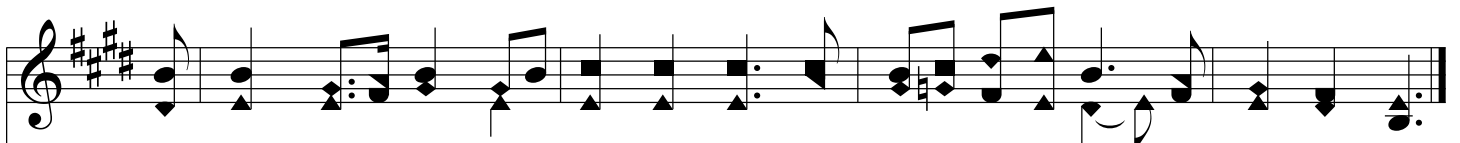
1. A - rise, O Lord, with heal - ing rod, Lift up Thine hand and save, O God;
